



## TOWN OF LUNENBURG SPRING AND FALL CLEAN UP

### GENERAL CLEAN UP

All clean up items must be placed curbside prior to 6:00 a.m. on your regular collection day during clean up week as per the dates indicated on the Solid Waste Collection Calendar. Items may be left behind if they exceed a total weight of 150 kg per household with no individual item/package to exceed 50 kg in weight or over 1.5 m in any dimension unless noted otherwise in this notice. Please place clean up items in a separate pile from your regular household waste.

Metal	Metal shelving, rims, bicycles, hot water tanks, pots and pans. Place metal in a separate pile from landfill clean up items.
Appliances	Fridges and freezers must have doors removed and display the Nova Scotia Department of Environment "Refrigerant Free" sticker.
Auto Parts	Small auto parts will be collected if all fluids have been drained and items are within weight limits.
Mowers	Please drain all fluids from lawn mowers.
Swing Sets	Must be broken down into 1.5 m (5 ft.) lengths or smaller.
Tanks and Drums	Oil tanks and drums must be cut in half and drained.
Construction Materials	Includes boards, plywood and drywall, within size and weight limits.
Fluorescent/Light Bulbs	Bulbs and broken glass are to be placed in a box that is sealed and clearly marked "broken glass".
Other Landfill Items	Includes furniture and carpets.

Do not place cans containing paint, household hazardous waste, propane tanks or tires out for pickup during clean up. Paint cans containing unused paint must be taken to an Enviro-Depot. Empty metal paint cans may be placed in your metal pile with lids off. Empty plastic paint cans may be placed in a black bag. Take refillable propane tanks and tires to the appropriate dealer. Containers with unidentified contents will not be collected.

Printers, computers and parts, televisions, home and car audio/video systems, cellular and non-cellular phones will not be picked up during clean up. Drop them off for FREE at Atlantic Canada Electronics Stewardship (ACES) and Recycle My Cell drop-off locations such as Corkum's Recycling in Oakhill or Lilydale.
